



## Trap Loan Reservations & Resources

When you call Operation Catnip to make a Catnip Sunday clinic reservation, you can make trap loan reservations at the same time if you don't own appropriate humane wire traps.

### *Reserve trap(s)*

Stray and feral community cats survive because they are smart and wary creatures who can't always be trapped. Please be realistic about the number of cats you expect to trap when making reservations. The maximum number of traps allowed per caregiver is 10. The Executive Director may increase or decrease this number on a case-by-case basis.

### *Pick Up trap(s)*

Trap pick-up week is generally scheduled two weeks before the clinic. You will be notified of exact pick-up dates when you make your reservation. The sooner you set out the traps, the more time the cats will have to become acclimated to them.

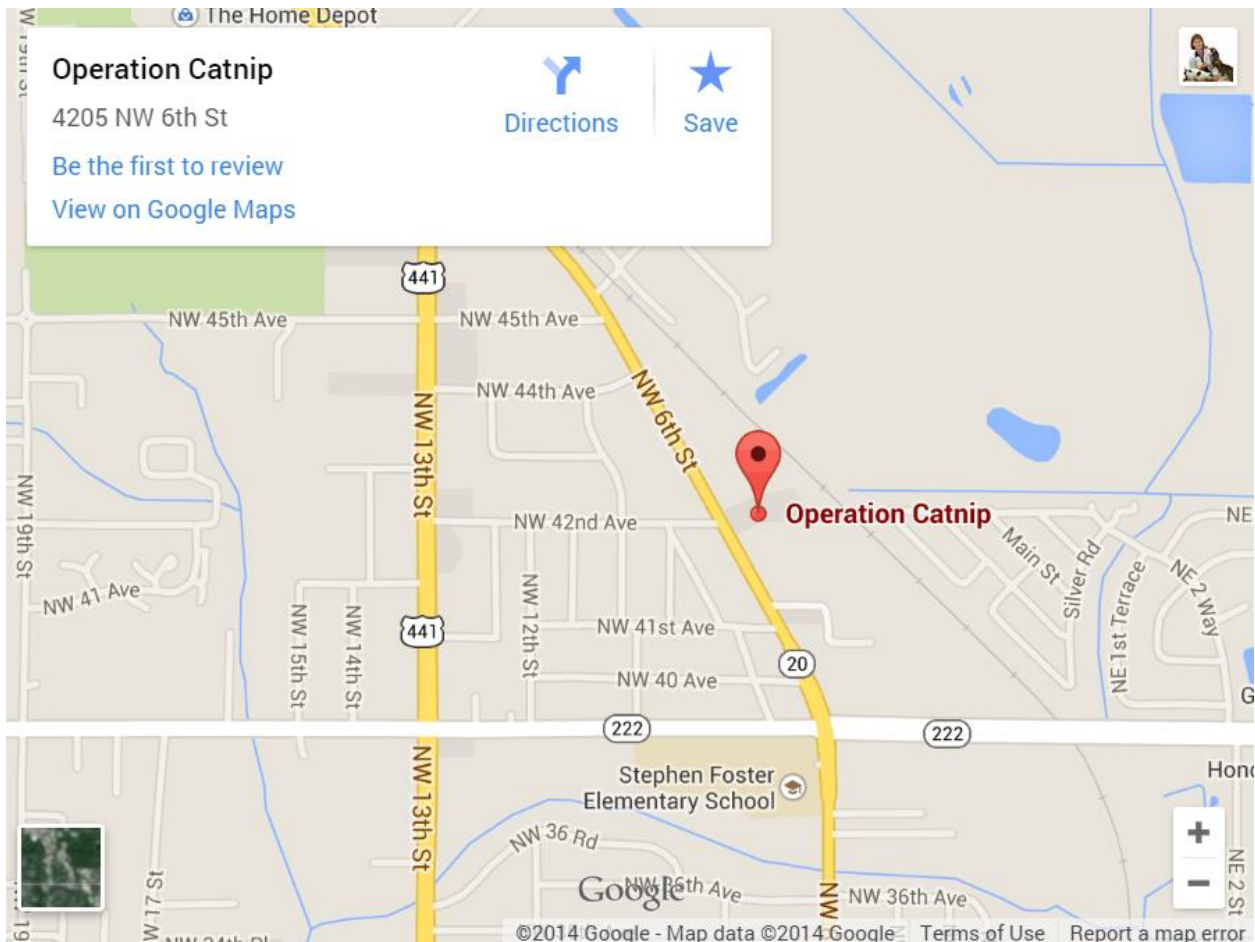
Only an Operation Catnip representative can loan traps for our clinics. A Catnip Sunday [clinic reservation](#) and a \$70 trap deposit are required. We accept cash, checks, credit or debit cards. Your deposit will be released when you return the trap within one week of the clinic.

Our trap storage is located at our office behind the Alachua County Humane Society at 4205 NW 6th St, Gainesville. Traps can be picked up and returned during office hours.

- ◆ Saturday between 9am and 12pm

## *Return traps*

To reclaim your deposit, return the borrowed traps clean and free of any paper or towels within one week of the clinic. If you are not successful in trapping any cats, return any borrowed traps, and make a reservation for the next Catnip Sunday clinic.
